# Steps to Apply for MPJE & NAPLEX

#### **Step 1: Check Eligibility Requirements**

Ensure you meet the basic requirements:

- Graduate from an ACPE-accredited pharmacy school
- Complete internship hours as per your state board
- Foreign graduates: Pass FPGEE and TOEFL iBT

Always check specific requirements with your state board of pharmacy.

## Step 2: Create a NABP e-Profile

Go to nabp.pharmacy and create an e-Profile. Make sure your personal info matches your ID. You'll manage all applications through this profile.

# Step 3: Apply for Eligibility Through Your State Board

Submit an eligibility request to your state board of pharmacy.

- Pay any state-specific fees
- Upload documents like transcripts and internship hour records

Approval timelines vary by state.

## Step 4: Apply for NAPLEX and/or MPJE in NABP Portal

Once eligible, log in to your NABP e-Profile and apply for the exams:

- NAPLEX: \$475

- MPJE: \$150 per jurisdiction

You'll receive an Authorization to Test (ATT) via email.

# Step 5: Schedule Your Exam with Pearson VUE

Visit Pearson VUE's website and use your ATT to book your exam.

Select your preferred date and location.

Bring valid ID and arrive early on exam day.

#### **Step 6: Prepare for the Exam**

Study using updated resources:

- Review competencies and state laws
- Use practice questions and flashcards

# **Step 7: Receive Your Scores**

Check your NABP profile for results (usually within 7 business days).

Passing score: 75+

If you fail, you can retake after 45 days.

## **Step 8: Complete State Licensing Requirements**


After passing both exams:
